Overview

The CEMOTO AEB31A is a step-thru commuter eBike aimed at everyday urban transport. Its defining feature is the low-step frame, which makes mounting and dismounting easy — particularly useful in stop-start traffic, in normal clothing, and for riders with limited hip flexibility.

CEMOTO describes it as combining a low-step frame with a reliable motor and comfortable geometry, delivering a smooth, efficient and enjoyable daily ride.

The AEB31A is listed as a single-variant product. Color options are not published on the store listing.

Specifications

Detailed specifications are not available for this model. CEMOTO's store listing for the AEB31A does not publish a specification table — motor rating, battery capacity, top speed, tire size, brake type, weight and carton dimensions are not stated for this model, and they are not documented here.

Numbers from other CEMOTO eBike models do not carry over: the range uses 500W and 750W motors, 13Ah / 15Ah / 15.6Ah packs, and 26" and 27.5" wheels depending on model.

Baseline safety rules that apply to every CEMOTO eBike:

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- **NEVER** carry a passenger on the electric bike.
 - **NEVER** modify the electric bike with unapproved accessories.
 - **NEVER** ride through deep water.
 - **NEVER** perform wheelies, jumps or trick stunts.
 - **AVOID** riding in the rain for long periods of time.
 - **AVOID** water contact with the motor and electric lines.
 - **ALWAYS** keep both hands on the handlebars.
 - **ALWAYS** inspect the electric bike before each ride to ensure a safe ride.
